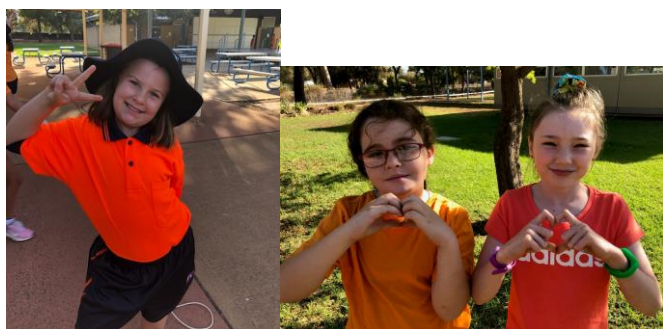
Principal's Report
