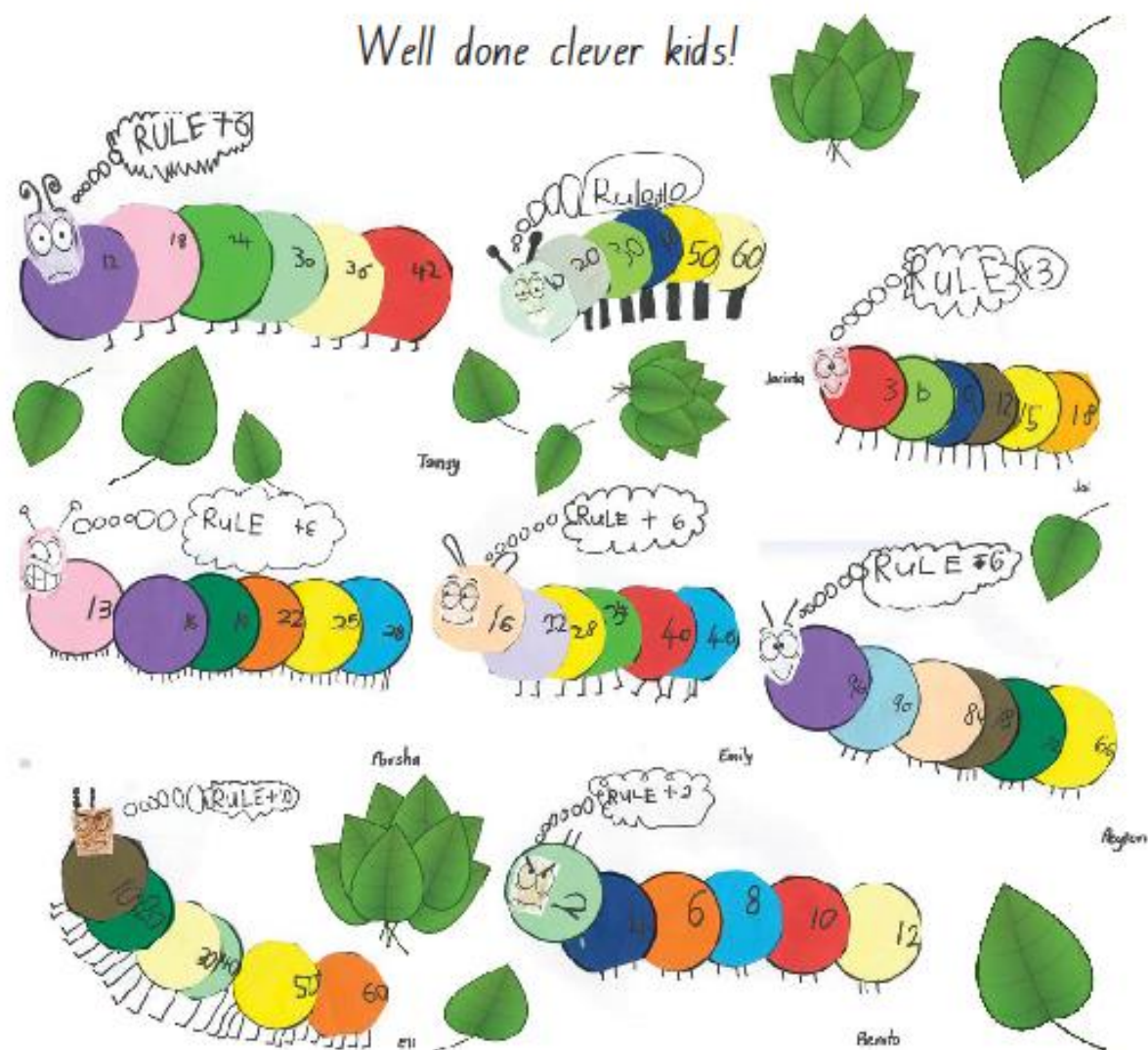

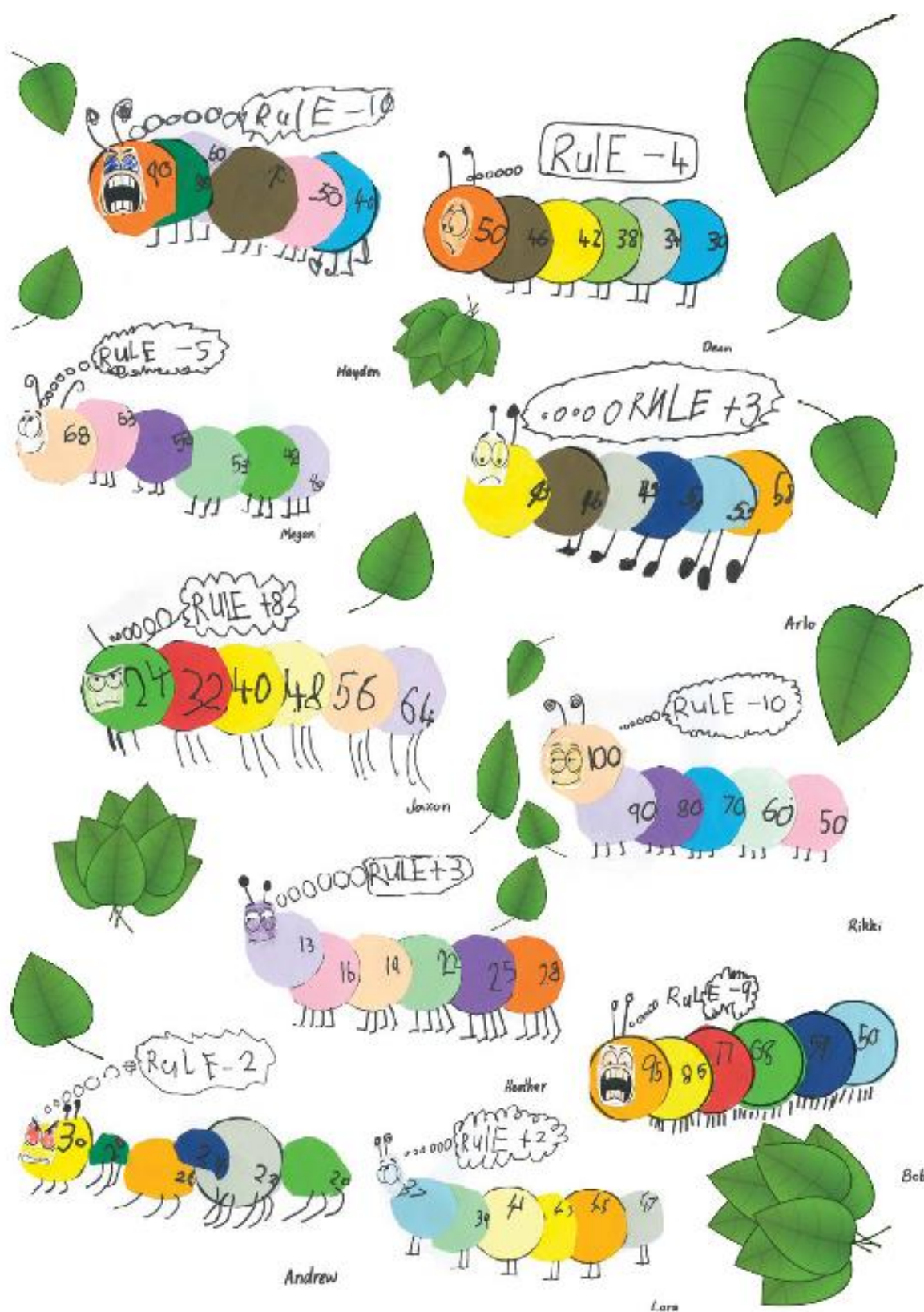
Creepy Crawlly
