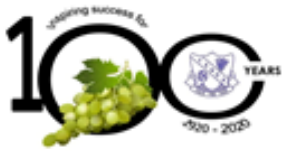
Channels 2019

Thank you for everyone's support. Our fundraiser was a huge success. Over 130 tickets were sold. A final amount raised will be in next week's newsletter.





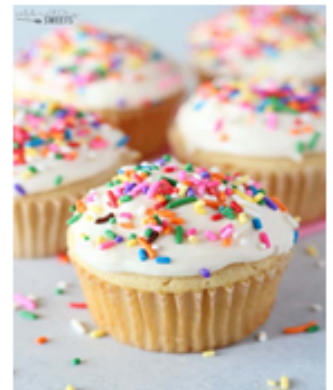
