Year 5 students wishing to nominate for School Captain for 2021 must reach Gold level by Friday 6 November (Term 4 Week 4).

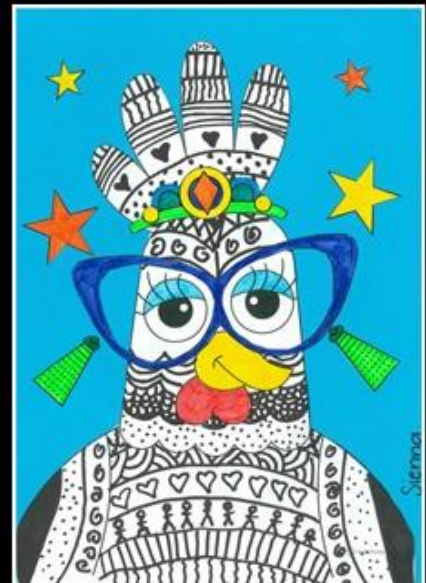

K/1B has had a wonderful time back at school this week! We have loved being back altogether and have had a special week celebrating National Simultaneous Storytime.

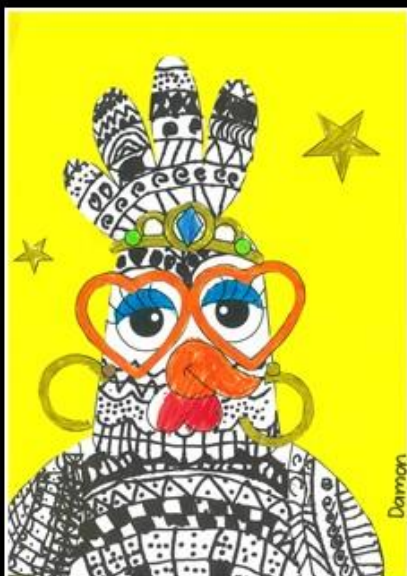


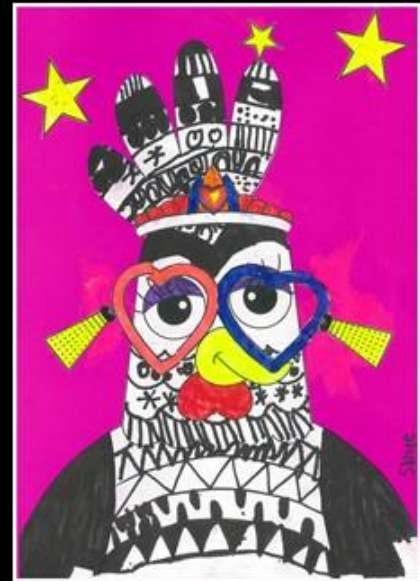
On Wednesday we read *Whitney and Britney Chicken Divas* by Lucinda Gifford at the same time as children all over Australia!
