Year 6 Farewell

Our Presentation Night will be held at the Griffith Regional Theatre. Tickets will be on sale soon. In following Theatre guidelines, please note that for students to attend Presentation Night, they must have at least one fully vaccinated parent present in the audience.

When purchasing Presentation Night tickets, all of those attending over 16 years old must have proof of two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine. Proof of vaccine will be asked both when purchasing tickets from the school office and upon entry to the Griffith Regional Theatre.

The Year 6 Farewell, will be held at the Yenda Diggers Club. Year 6 students and staff are invited to attend. Parents of Year 6 students are invited to attend to accompany their child but must show proof of 2 doses of a COVID-19 vaccine upon entry to the Farewell. Students must be accompanied by at least one fully vaccinated parent in order to attend the farewell.

There will be further, more specific information regarding these end-of-year events soon (following COVID-19 guidelines).

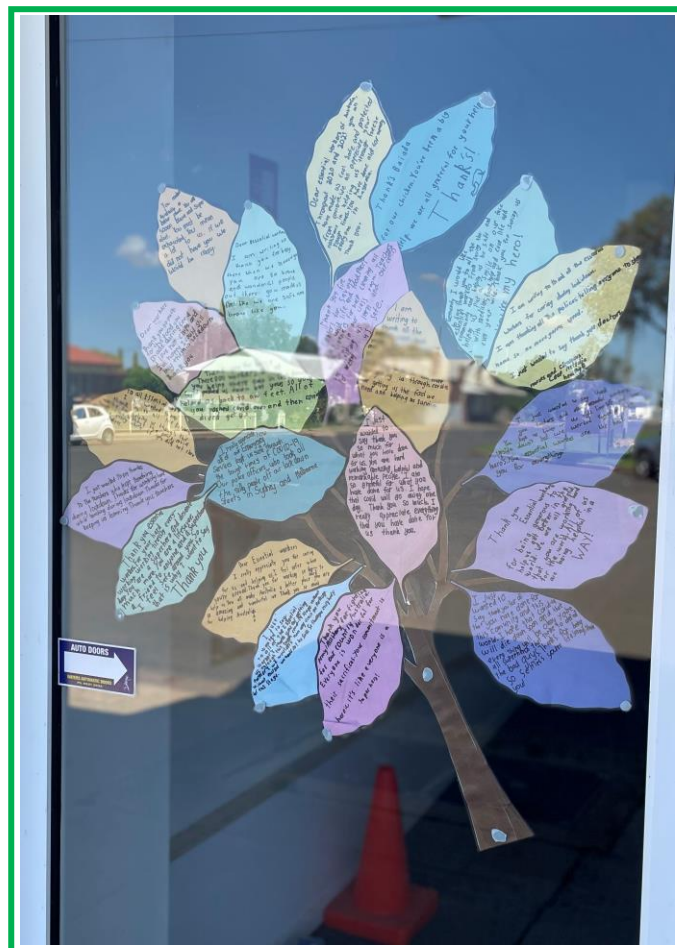

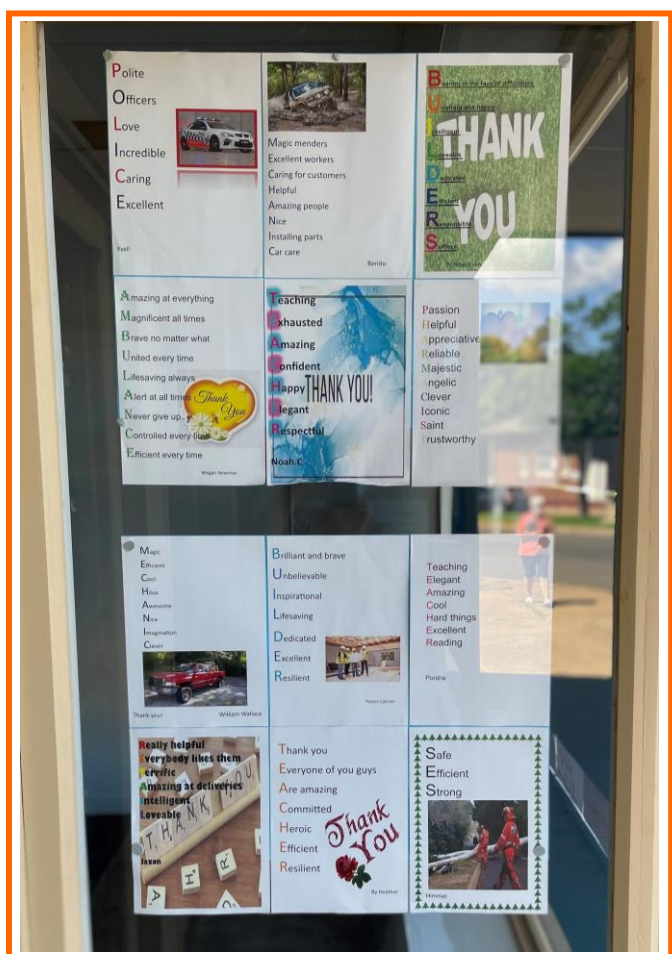
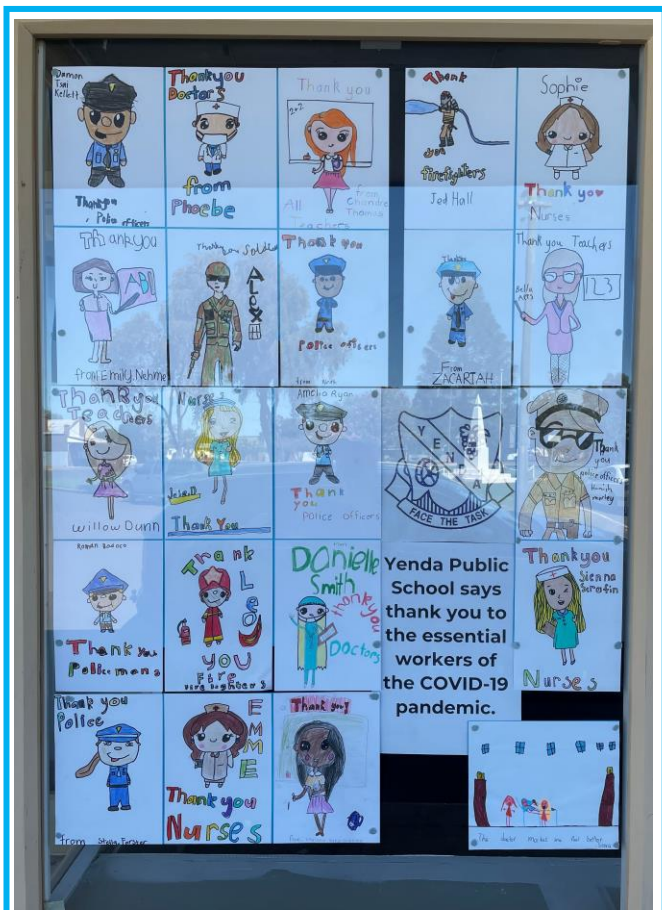
Our next P&C Meeting will take place on Tuesday 16 November at 6:30pm via Zoom. Please contact the school office if you require the password for this Zoom meeting.

K/1B have been learning all about birds this term! We loved bird watching for the Aussie Backyard Bird Count, reading and writing about birds and lots of amazing bird art!



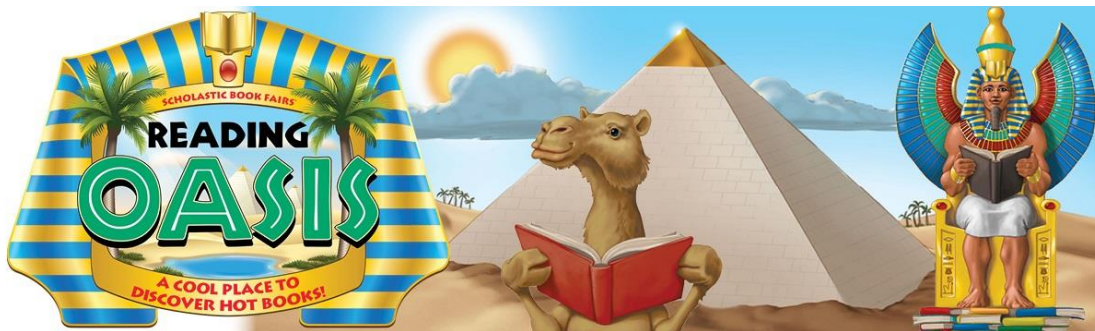
