Our 2023 Kindergarten Orientation has commenced. The following are the dates and times for Orientation each week:







New K-2 English and Mathematics Syllabuses

This year, we have been one of only two schools in our region selected to trial the new K-2 English and Mathematics syllabuses and associated units of work. This trial has taken place in our 1/2D classroom, and is known state-wide as the Accelerated Adopter initiative. Next year, the new K-2 English and Mathematics syllabuses will be implemented in all NSW schools in the infants grades.

Being in the Accelerated Adopter initiative has allowed us to be at the forefront of trialling the implementation of the new syllabuses and units of work, as well as providing feedback to the curriculum team and for staff involved to undertake professional learning. Thank you to both Mrs Drayton and Mrs Chilvers for all of their work in this area throughout 2022.


Cupcake Donations Required
