It would be great to have all families signed up and using this app for all future school payments. Currently we have 80% of students registered.

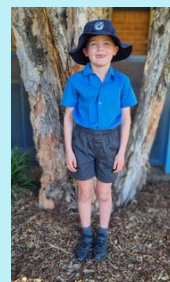
