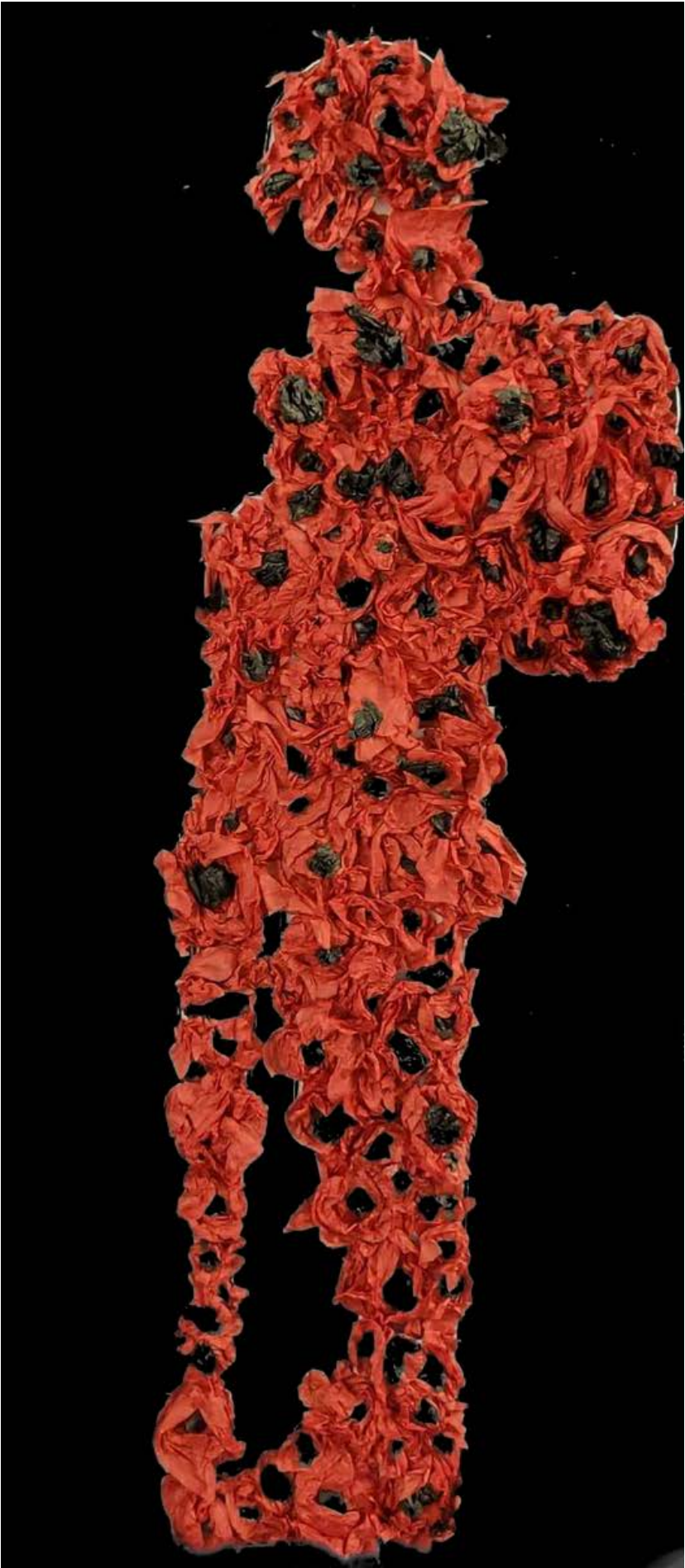


Remembrance Day in 1/2Q

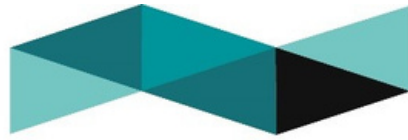
