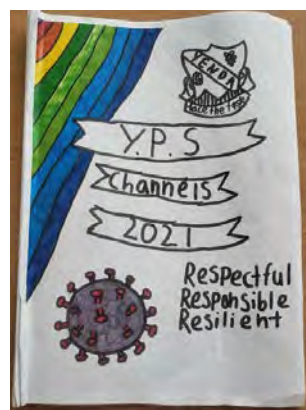
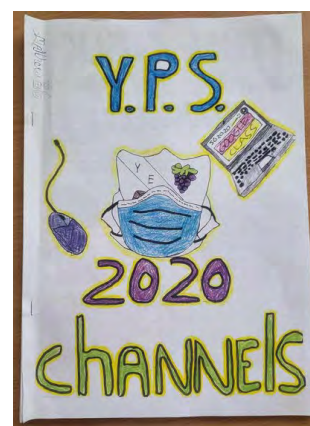

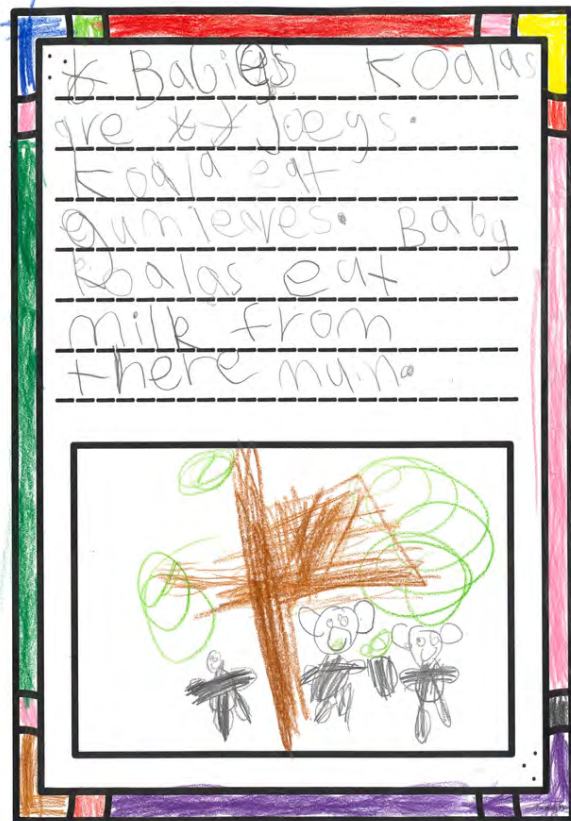
Channels 2023

Order forms have been sent home with students today. If you would like to purchase a copy of Channels 2023 for \$10 please return the note and money to the office.



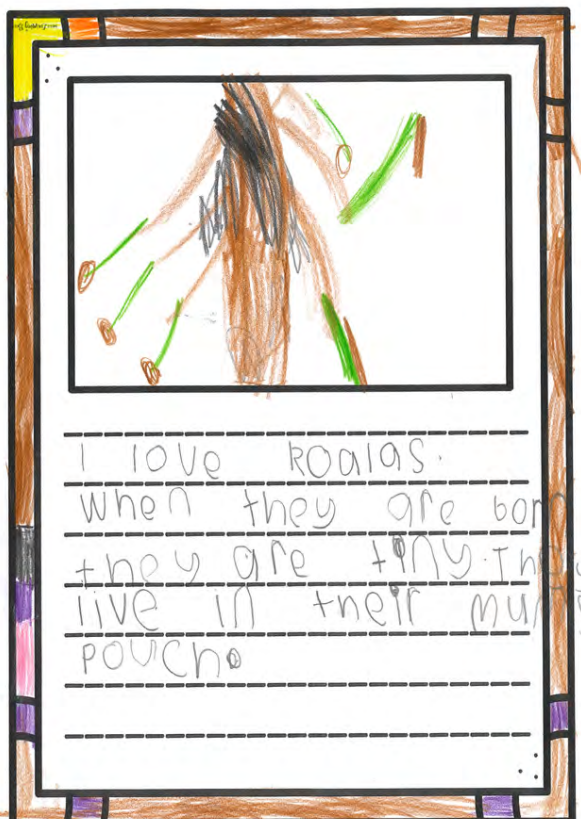
