Under the sea with 1/2 P


1/2P have been working with the text 'Our Island' by the children of Gununa with Alison Lester and Elizabeth Honey.

In the peaceful sea, the majestic turtle glides through the green sea grass.






In the big blue ocean, the medium turtle grazes on the long green kelp.




In the turquoise sea, the hungry turtle eats the green seaweed.






In the salty sea, the big turtle floats on top of the water.



In the blue sea there is a big green turtle near the rocks eating the long green grass. He flaps his flippers to glide along.






In the deep blue sea, the beautiful turtle glides through the salty water.



In the turquoise sea, the big hungry turtle grazes on seaweed.






Under the stormy turquoise sea, the happy turtle plays with his friends.




In the blue ocean, the green turtle swims home.





Through the deep blue sea, the majestic turtle glides gracefully.




Under the coral bridge, the little green turtle grazes on the sea grass.





In the blue sea, the giant turtle glides through the short seaweed.




Under the salty, clear water, the small turtle plays near the coral.


