#### IMPORTANT: 3-Way Goal Setting Meetings

#### **Class Structures at YPS**

What are the stages in NSW curriculum?

When deciding on class structures for the year there are many things to take into consideration. This is a process that takes time and careful planning; taking into account the best learning environment for each child.

Children in NSW are placed into classes based on their chronological age. All children learn at different paces within every class. The classroom teacher meets every child at their own point of need. All lessons are differentiated for every child, so that they are learning at their own point of need.

If you have any questions regarding your child's learning, please make an appointment to speak to your child's classroom teacher.

#### **Sport and PE lessons**

In NSW, teachers follow the NSW syllabus teaching requirements and time allocation of subjects. Teachers need to allocate at least 1 hour 30 minutes to physical activity per week. **Whole school sport this term is on Thursdays** due to NRL workshop availability. All other classes have scheduled their PE lessons around their timetable. Please look at the table below for the days your child wears sport uniform.

#### URGENT- General Permission Notes through School Bytes

At the start of each year, we send out general permission notes which provides written permission for your child to participate in various activities.

#### NAPLAN 2024 Parent and Carer Information

Each year the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is undertaken by students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. Students will participate in tests for writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

#### NAPLAN 2024 will take place from Wednesday 13 March to Monday 25 March.

NAPLAN is just one part of our school learning assessment program. The tests assess literacy and numeracy skills your child is already learning at school.

In preparation for NAPLAN, our school will undertake activities to help students become familiar with the format and functionality of the online tests. These activities are not an assessment of student ability and will not be marked. Excessive preparation for NAPLAN is not required nor recommended. The public demonstration site (<u>https://www.nap.edu.au/online-assessment/public-demonstration-site</u>) is available to see the types of questions, tools and functions used in the NAPLAN tests.
